BEST PRACTICE 1:

1. Current Awareness Service through Library What's app and Telegram Groups

2. OBJECTIVES:

- ➤ To provide a digital platform for utilisation of library resources
- ➤ To encourage the usage of electronic resources.
- ➤ To give users with up-to-date information/knowledge.
- To extend the Kannada and English newspapers clippings service.
- > To keep update the job notifications.
- To stay up to date on new books arriving in the library.
- ➤ To ensure that library resources are used effectively.
- > To reduce the burden on library staff.
- To maintain direct communication with the entire DVS user community.

3. Context that required the initiated of the practice:

DVS College of Arts and Science, Shivamogga affiliated to Kuvempu University. Our college library created WhatsApp and Telegram groups to share the current knowledge via smart phone. Every day, student can access the information such as News Papers clippings with current affairs, Current Job notifications, Journal Article alerts, some open source News Papers in Kannada and English language, New Arrival Books alerts and College and Library notices. Through WhatsApp and Telegram students and staff can access the library's current information from anywhere at any time during the day.

4. The Practice:

Our librarian created "DVS Library & Information Center" WhatsApp and Telegram group to share the current knowledge, current Job notification, competitive exam question papers with answer and current library and college notification to its group members. In this regard, a WhatsApp and Telegram message has been distributed and students are obliged to join this group without fail. As a result, Student began to join the club at the same time. We changed the group settings to "Admin Only Send Message." As a result, all group members can only see what we have shared. This obviously ensures that superfluous and bothersome communications are avoided. The student flow motivates us to share extremely recent knowledge with the group. Currently, the WhatsApp group has 984 members and Telegram Group 445 Members out of a total of 1600 students. Some student is unable to participate





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since they do not have a smart phone. As a result, we advise those students to visit the library to obtain the same resources in hard form.

We began sharing daily open access news publications clippings in both Kannada and English after first forming the WhatsApp and Telegram groups. Some commerce students requested that information on commerce be shared. As a result, we began sharing Economic Times news pieces on a daily basis. In addition, librarian scan recent material such as political, economic, social, technological, and educational items in both Kannada and English and disseminate it in pdf format in the library WhatsApp and Telegram group. Furthermore, we exchange recent competitive examination question papers and answer information in the Library and information centre groups, which is well-liked by its members.

This WhatsApp and Telegram groups serves as an excellent medium for reaching the college largest community in a direct and quick manner. Any library or college emergency notifications were shared in this group to keep everyone up to date on the latest college news. Constant user feedback motivates us to offer more useful information with the user community.

5. Evidence of Success:

We had difficulties with student privacy; several female students were concerned that their cell phone number would be available to everyone in the group. As a result, we advised all students to change their What's app and telegram privacy settings so that unfamiliar people cannot view their profile picture or personal information. Some students report that some undesired and irrelevant content may cause them to run out of internet time. As a result, we advised them to disable the option to download data in either mobile or wifi mode, so that students could pick what content they could download and all.

6. Impact of the practice:

This has resulted in a huge rise in student visits to the library. The total number of visitors in 2021 was to be around 4500. However, in 2023, the number of visitors to the library climbed dramatically, reaching 8540. Sharing current information via WhatsApp and Telegram group raises student community understanding of library culture and services.
